

On 23.12.2016, at S.S.T College of Arts and Commerce, Ulhasnagar-4, a one-day seminar on women's safety was held. Asst. Prof. Deepa Agrawal Department of Information Technology gave the program's introduction. The session was attended by 31 students. Ms.Jyoti Sardar guest speaker discussed how to be more responsive than reactive, more observant, and attain cognitive awareness, as well as how to be patient, understanding, adaptable, and regulate the mind.

Following were the highlights of the Seminar:

- Safety: The primary importance of self-defence is for women to be able to protect themselves against anything that's unacceptable in terms of social conduct.
- Confidence: There is nothing more empowering than having the confidence to analyze a dangerous situation and take actions to overcome them effectively.
- Empowerment: It empowers women to lead a healthy and fulfilling life by encouraging them to deal with stressful and dangerous situations independently.
- Discipline: It teaches discipline which transfers over to all other areas of life. It helps women be calmer, understanding, and flexible, gain body and mind control, be more responsive than reactive, more observant, and achieve cognitive awareness.
- Reduces Dependency: Just because you're a woman, you shouldn't be asked to travel with a companion! That's what learning self-defense does – it makes you independent, helping you protect yourself in every situation.
- Health and Fitness: Self-Defense programs are also a fun way of exercising and building a healthy body, thereby improving physical and mental health.
